TODDLER 18 MONTHS - 2.5 YEARS

18 months by September 1st.

Through purposeful play activities children develop the foundational skills in literacy, math, science, fine and gross motor skills and social-emotional development.

- The Toddler Program introduces the children to IB PYP in a loving and caring environment.
- Focuses on vocabulary, communication, simple academic concepts, understanding of sharing and friendships.
- Through safe and well-organized classrooms with consistent routines, our Toddlers thrive in their first school experience.

PRESCHOOL 2.5 - 4 YEARS

Students turning 2.5 and 3 years old and potty trained by September 1st it includes students turning 4 years old after September 1st

The child is at the center of all learning which allows our teachers to address individual strengths and weaknesses and to foster each child's learning journey.

- The Preschoolers explore the IB's Units of Inquiry, and as they study them, they learn WHY they should know something and HOW it connects to other subjects and the world around them.
- It focuses on speaking and listening to communicate, problem solving, and exploring by observing and asking questions.

TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN 4 - 5 YEARS

Turning 4 and 5 years old by September 1st Children of this age are naturally enthusiastic learners.

They love to ask questions and their curiosity is fostered through the central ideas of the PYP units of inquiry.

- The next important step toward becoming readers, providing a language-rich classroom with a variety of activities that focuses on print, emergent phonics, and word analysis skills.
- They demonstrate understanding through role play and mini presentations

KINDERGARTEN TURNS 5 BY SEPTEMBER 1ST.

- The students study each unit of inquiry in depth through a variety of learning situations incorporating whole group activities, small group collaboration, independent work and one on one instruction time with the teacher.
- Kinder students learn reading & writing skills, they engage with math concepts, and are immersed in Spanish language.
